Training Feature Update: Training & Tracking

Launch Date: April 6, 2022

Coming in April, we will be relabelling the "Training" feature to "Training & Tracking". This is because the training page is not just for employees to access their online courses. Did you know you can also use it to track external training records right on employee's profiles? This includes training records for courses like First Aid, Respiratory Fit Testing, JHSC Certification, and more (these are generally referred to as placeholders). Administrators can upload these external training records and employees can receive credit directly on their training pages along with the copies of their certificates. You can also place these records under a tracking "service" on your training page (see below for an example). Use Systems 24-7 for all your tracking needs!

Forced Ordering

Do you use Systems 24-7 to build your own training? Did you know a course can have multiple modules below it? For courses that have multiple modules, you now have the option of determining whether the ordering is forced or not. On the module home page, you will see a setting at the bottom of the page to determine whether the modules need to be taken in order by the user. If this is turned off, this means an employee can choose which module in the list to complete. Regardless of order, all modules within a course still need to be finished in order for the course to be marked as complete.

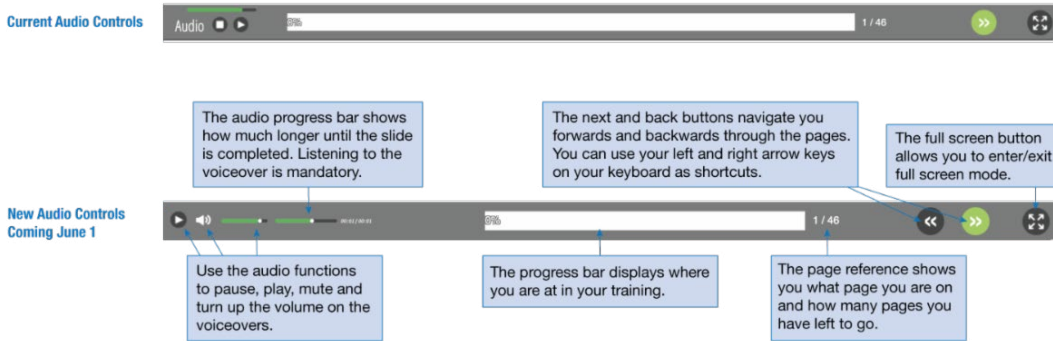

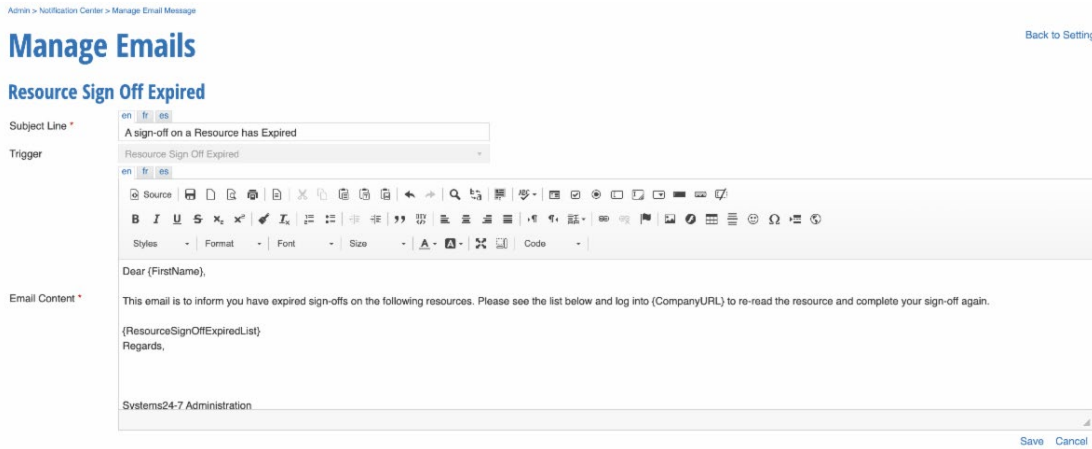

New Email Template: Resource Expired

For those with libraries on Systems 24-7 (policies, forms, etc.) a new email template has been added. When enabled in the notification centre, this email will provide a list to employees that includes resources in the libraries that have expired sign-offs. Like our other notifications, these emails can be copied to an administrator for follow up.



Update to Manage Employee Page

You asked for it, and we listened! You now have two options to search for employees on the manage employee page.

OPTION 1:

You can type in the employees first name, last name or username into the search user field and we'll display employees that match your criteria in the dropdown. You can then quickly select them from the dropdown and it will open the user in the results.

OPTION 2:

You can now search for employees with their partial names or usernames and then select the search button. For example, you could type in "Sar" and then find all employees on your site with "Sar" in their first name, last name or username. In the displayed results, you can manually look for the employee you wish to update.

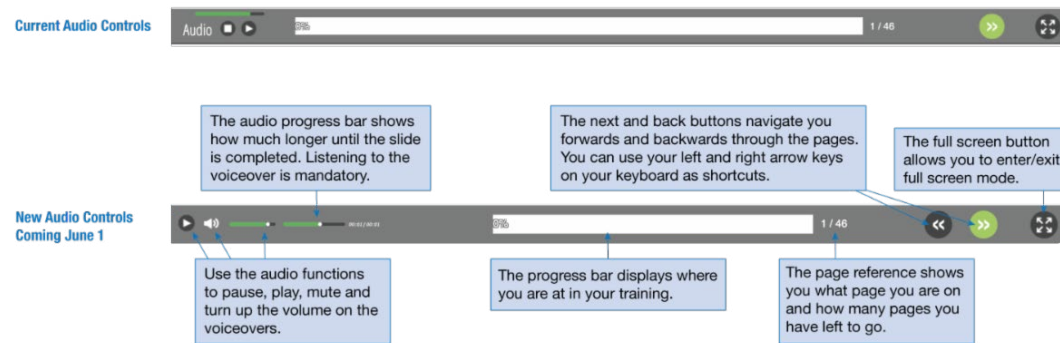

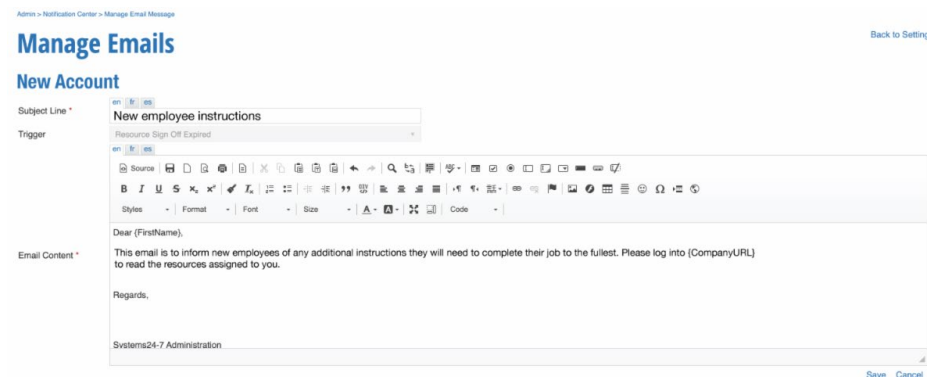
Course Audio Player: Release Date June 1st, 2022

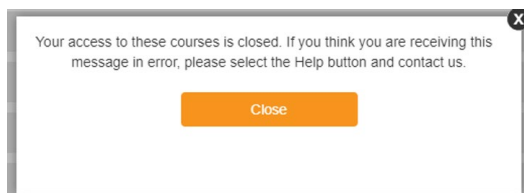

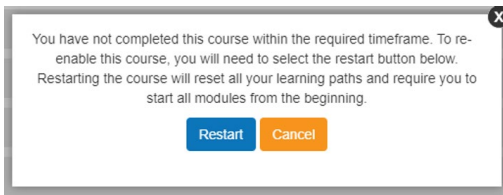

Restart Course After 'Complete By' Date Has Passed

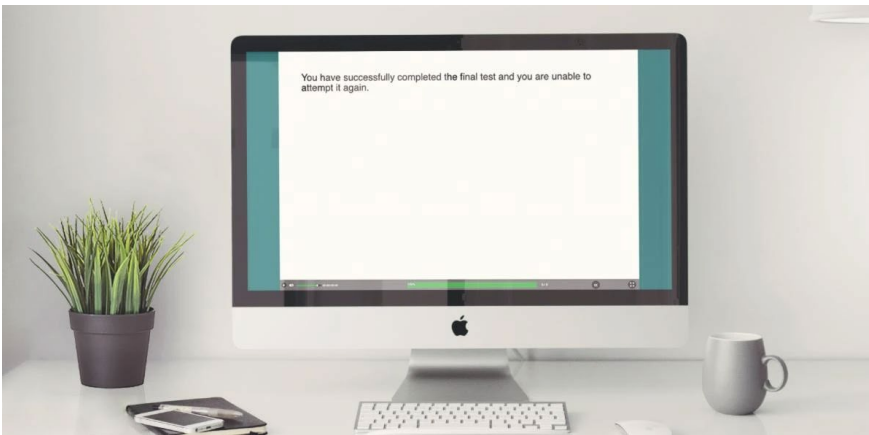
Do you have your own courses on Systems 24-7? Have you ever wished that users would be forced to re-start your courses if they fail to complete them within their "complete by" date? You are in luck! A company setting is now available to apply this feature to your courses across your organization. When a course has a due date, meaning the date in which a user must complete it after it has been assigned, Systems 24-7 can now force users to take the training again from the beginning. This means all their progress will be reset and they start back at square one. This can be a great motivational

tool to ensure employees are getting their training finished within the designated time period. Please email support@systems24-7.com for more information.



Limit Final Tests After Completion

A new tool was added to limit final tests after completion. In short, when this setting is enabled, once an employee successfully completes their final tests in their courses, this setting will turn off the ability of the learner to be able to attempt the test again for a specified time period. Employees or learners can still review the courses, however, they are unable to complete the test during the length of the limitation. This is specifically useful if you are sending your scores to another program, such as your payroll system, via API. Please email support@systems24-7.com for more information.



For example: John Doe completes the course “My Code of Conduct” and fails to achieve the 75% pass on his final test. The same day, he completes the test again and achieves 75%. Three days later, he tries to access his test again to re-write it and get a higher score, but now he receives a message on his test, “You have successfully completed this final test. You are unable to attempt the test and submit it again.”

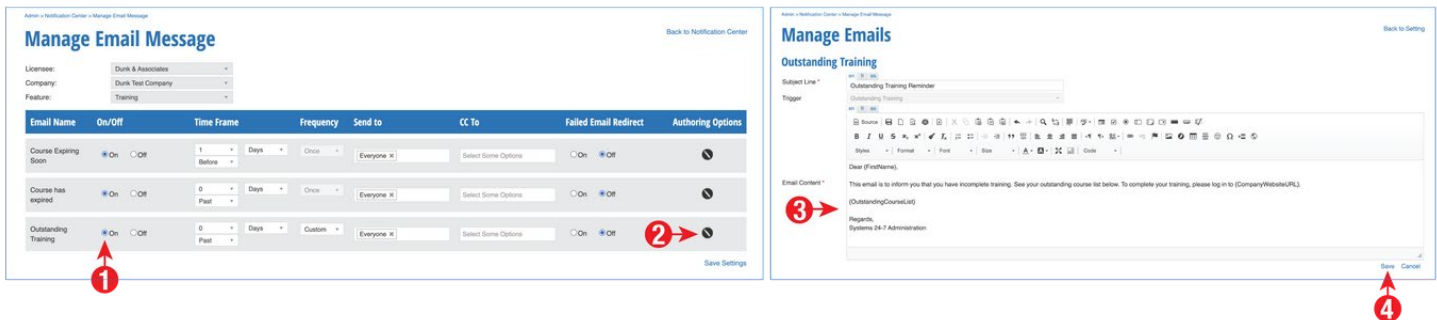

New Email Template: Outstanding Training

A new email template is available for use under the notification centre. By enabling this email, your organization can send employees a list of their outstanding training. Don't like the content we've defaulted in the template? Customize it! In addition, your organization can determine the frequency this email is sent, such as daily, weekly, monthly, etc. It's a great way to ensure assigned training is completed.

To enable this email, go to Admin - Notification Centre. Select "training" in the feature menu and turn on and edit the "Outstanding Training" email.



Removing Employee "Delete" Button

Systems 24-7 has been updated to remove the delete button "x" from the Manage Employee Feature. We have done this because employers are required to retain employee records, including training records, for a period of time. Some jurisdictions have specific requirements for the length of time that Health & Safety records must be kept, which include, in some cases, after the employee is no longer employed by your company. Even if your province/territory doesn't have a specific timeline for retaining records, at some point you may be required to produce employee records for employees no longer employed. This may be for legal reasons or for worker's compensation cases, or may be needed if the employee comes back to work for you in the future.

Please note, when an employee no longer works for you, you can deactivate them in the Manage Employee Settings function, so they will no longer show up in any of your reports, and they will not count towards the overall user count on the system.

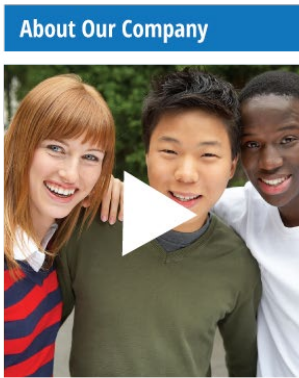

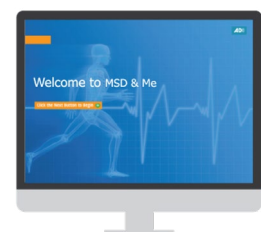
